NEW YORK, NEW YORK – January 22, 2019 – CONFESSIONS OF A FLASH ARTIST, a novella by Renald lacovelli, has been published.

In *Confessions of a Flash Artist*, Dr. Humphrey Humdinger, a professor at the City University of New York, relates his discovery of "Dramatic Exposure," an avant-garde art form by which an actor, in creatively exposing himself, produces in only a few minutes the kind of mystery and tension that is rarely attained by even the best in conventional theater and movies. As the professor is quick to point out, his art has nothing to do with "flashing" in the commonly-accepted notion of that word; rather, it is a legitimate and great leap forward in the dramatic art and requires a correspondingly exceptional degree of talent.
